St. Gregory's Catholic Primary School PE and Sport Expenditure 23/24

There are 5 key indicators (KI) that schools are expected to see improvement in:

Key Indicator 1: The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – Chief Medical Officer Guidelines recommend that primary school children undertake at least 30 minutes of physical activity a day in school.

Key Indicator 2: The profile of PE and sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.

Key Indicator 3: Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport.

Key Indicator 4: Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
Key Indicator 5: Increased participation in competitive sport

<p>Curriculum</p> <p>KI1, KI2, KI3, KI4</p>	<p>£10, 638.00</p>	<p>School bought into a full PE package with Ultimate Kids, having experienced through clubs they had provided, how excellent their delivery of PE sessions proved. The Teachers were provided with full training in all sporting areas during PE sessions, to encourage professional development in PE and Sport. Ultimate Kids also attended competitions with the children, building on the coaching they had received in PE lessons to participate in competitions.</p> <p>School also bought into a scheme with Intensity Sports for football sessions. The sessions were delivered to children in all areas and developed the children's skills to enable them to participate in inter-school competitions.</p>
<p>Sports Equipment</p> <p>KI1, KI4</p>	<p>£7,595.00</p>	<p>School purchased an outdoor trim trail to enhance the KS2 children's exercise during play/lunchtimes. This equipment is also accessed during PE lessons too.</p>

Expenditure	Amount	Impact
CPD KI1, KI2, KI3, KI4	£333.37	Children in KS2 had access to Forest School, provided by an external company. This enhanced children's development of outdoor learning.
Competitions KI1, KI2, KI3, KI4	£1,560.00	School participated in local inter-schools competitions, football competitions and a tennis whole class event. This allowed children of all abilities to participate in a full range of competitions.
Celebrations KI1, KI2, KI3, KI4	£520.99	To celebrate the children's successes in PE and Sport, we provided many cups and medals for the children for their efforts. This encouraged all the children to really try hard in every aspect of the sport and also encouraged the children who were lacking confidence to believe more in themselves in the future.
