Extra Curricular Activities	£2872.00	We continue to invest heavily in coaches who provide excellent coaching sessions for our children before and after school. This year we set up a partnership with St. Helen's Rugby League club to help provide children with access to different sporting opportunities. We also brought in the winner of ITV's Ninja Warrior to demonstrate and run an acrobatics session with the children.
Equipment	£12,000	This year we invested money in accessories including hoops, balls and howlers to help us top up existing equipment. We also paid for an Astroturf football pitch to provide the children with high quality facilities for the children to hone their skills.
Bought in Curriculum Services	£770.00	At the start of this year we struck up 2 community partnerships with Beth Tweddle Total Gymnastics organisation. We have invested heavily in them, so that our school can benefit from weekly PE lessons. This means that our children and our staff can receive the best coaching and will help us go forward in the future delivering lessons with confidence.
Payment for Schools Programmes	£475.00	We have once again paid to be a part of The Chesterfield High School Sports programme which gives opportunities for schools and their children to perform in a variety of sports against other schools in the local area. We have also paid money towards hiring transport to transport the children to various school competitions.

Sports Leaders	£433.00	<p>The uptake for our sports leadership programme has increased year on year. Therefore we decided to invest in some professional training for our Year 6 children. We invested in bring Everton Football Club coaches into the school to run a youth sports coaching programme for our keen sports coaches. We also purchased T-shirts for the children to wear throughout their sessions.</p>
