Expenditure	Amount	Impact
Extra Curricular Activities	£298.08	We invested in coaches to deliver lunch and after school clubs. These clubs included American football, handball and street dance. The success of our clubs programme continues to improve year on year.
Equipment	£1103.24	New cricket equipment was purchased to help the children improve their basic skills and thus develop their skills in preparation for any upcoming competitions. Money was also spent on purchasing paralympic equipment including boccia and curling. This meant that the children who have physical needs could access the curriculum.
Bought in Curriculum Services	£1220.00	An investment was made in bringing in trained coaches to help the staff develop their skills, this included a professional coach and a secondary school teacher.
Payment for Schools Programmes	£350.00	This money was used to enable us to enter teams into a variety of Sefton competitions.
Clubs	£690.00	Improving the equipment and coaching was essential in improving the attraction of the clubs programme for all children. A key focus was ensuring that a wider variety of activities was accessible to all children of all ages.
Entrance Fee to Competition	£70.74	This payment was made for the school to have access to football and swimming competitions.
Staff Development Costs	£75.00	A tennis coach was brought in to train the staff in delivering PE lessons. Meanwhile a member of staff was sent on a PE course to help her deliver PE lessons and after school clubs.
Awards	£70.84	At the end of year we held a Sports Celebration assembly, were we celebrated the success of our teams and individuals. These children were presented with medals.

Improvement for play areas	239.57	We spent some of our funding on bring in a company to inspect our equipment, so that we could make any necessary changes. We also built and painted a new rock climbing wall on our playground for the children to use.
Trips for sports leaders	200.00	This money was used to send our Sports Leaders on a trip to Jump Nation. This was an opportunity for the school to say thank you for all of their hard work.
