Expenditure	Amount	Impact
Extra Curricular Activities	£298.08	We invested in coaches to deliver lunch and after school clubs. This had a huge impact as the % of children taking part in clubs rose by 30%. These clubs included darts, golf, boxing, lacrosse and dodgeball.
Equipment	£1505.88	Two new outdoor weatherproof table tennis tables were purchased to give the children a wider variety of activities to play outside.  Top up of existing equipment ( including footballs, bibs, cones, tennis rackets etc..) meant that the staff and children were able to make use of new reliable equipment.
Bought in Curriculum Services	£695.00	New lesson plans were purchased to provide the staff with wider access to the planning and delivery of PE lessons.
Payment for Schools Programmes	£1516.66	A large investment was made in acquiring the coaching assistance from a Professional football coach and a secondary school teacher. This gave the staff an opportunity to observe and gather new ideas on ways to deliver their lessons. The impact of the this was that the staff's self-confidence in PE increased accordingly.  We also spent £350 for the school to be part of the Chesterfield High Sports Programme. This meant that we could enter more teams into competitions whilst also giving more children an opportunity to represent the school.
