Monday 16th December – Choir Christmas Concert at 4.30pm for families

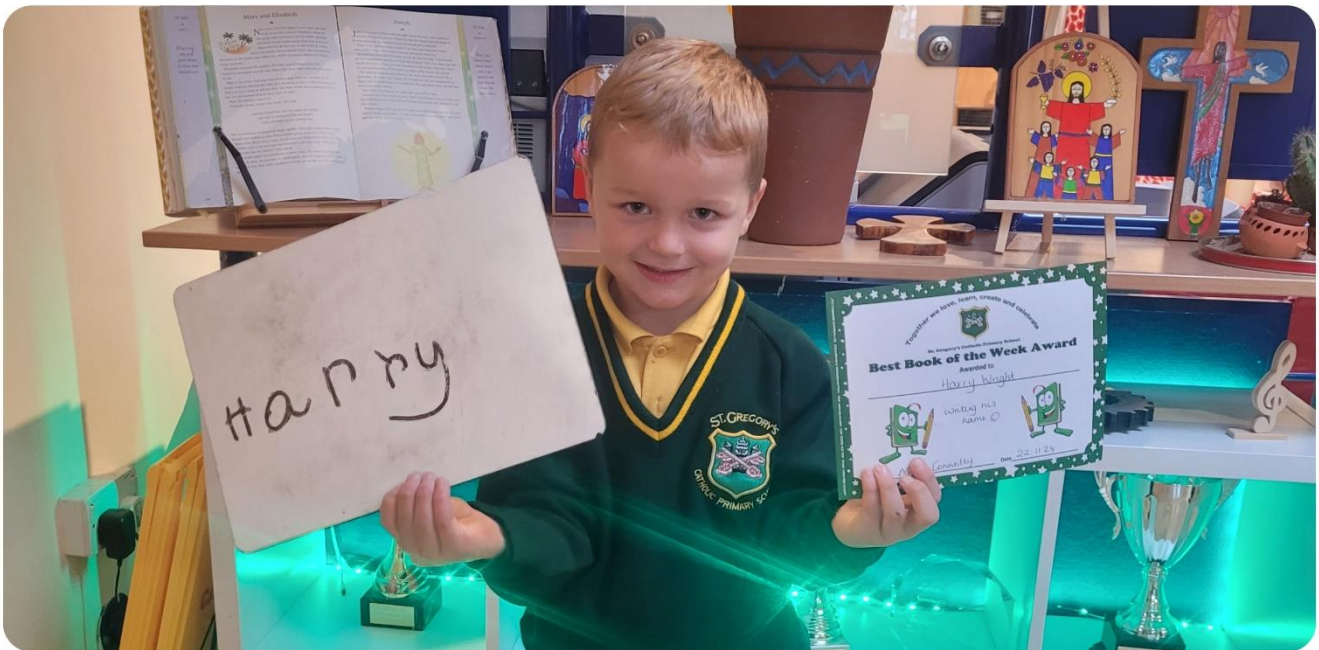
