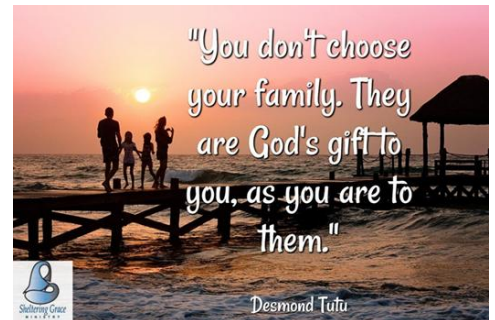
Message from Mrs Albon.....
