Upon arrival, the children had to ramble through the countryside to get to Barhaugh Hall. The walk was breathtaking and really prepared the children for what was to come!



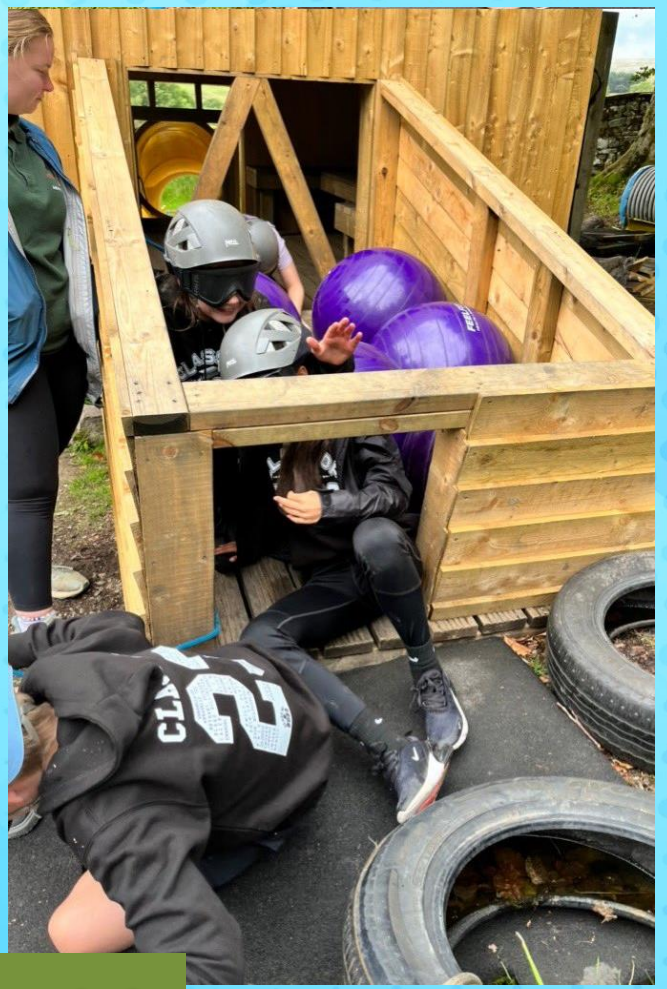


GOOD MORNING CAMPERS

After a well-earned peaceful night's sleep, the children were treated to a hearty breakfast – setting them up for a full day of activities, adventures and fun!

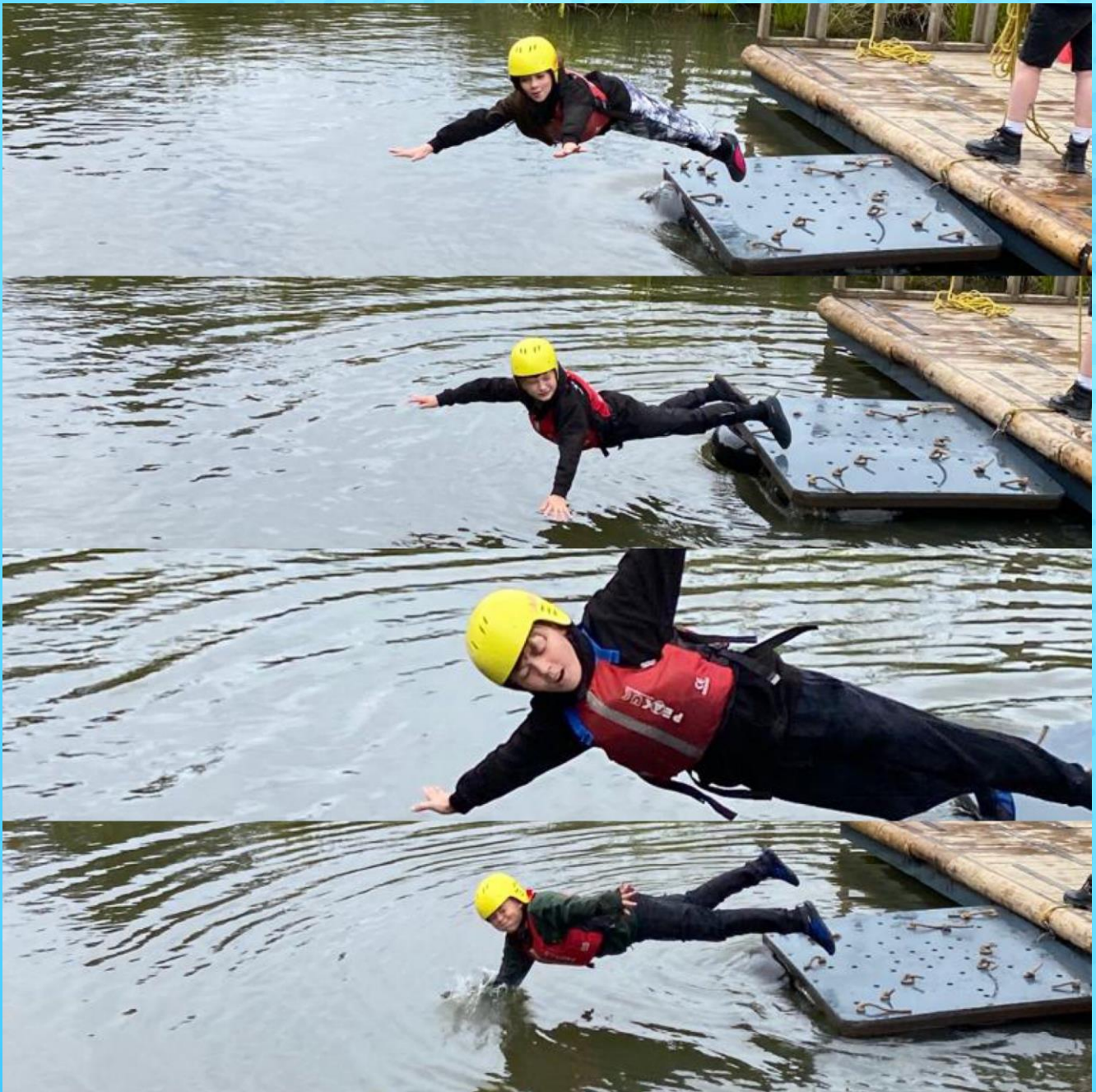
