resting

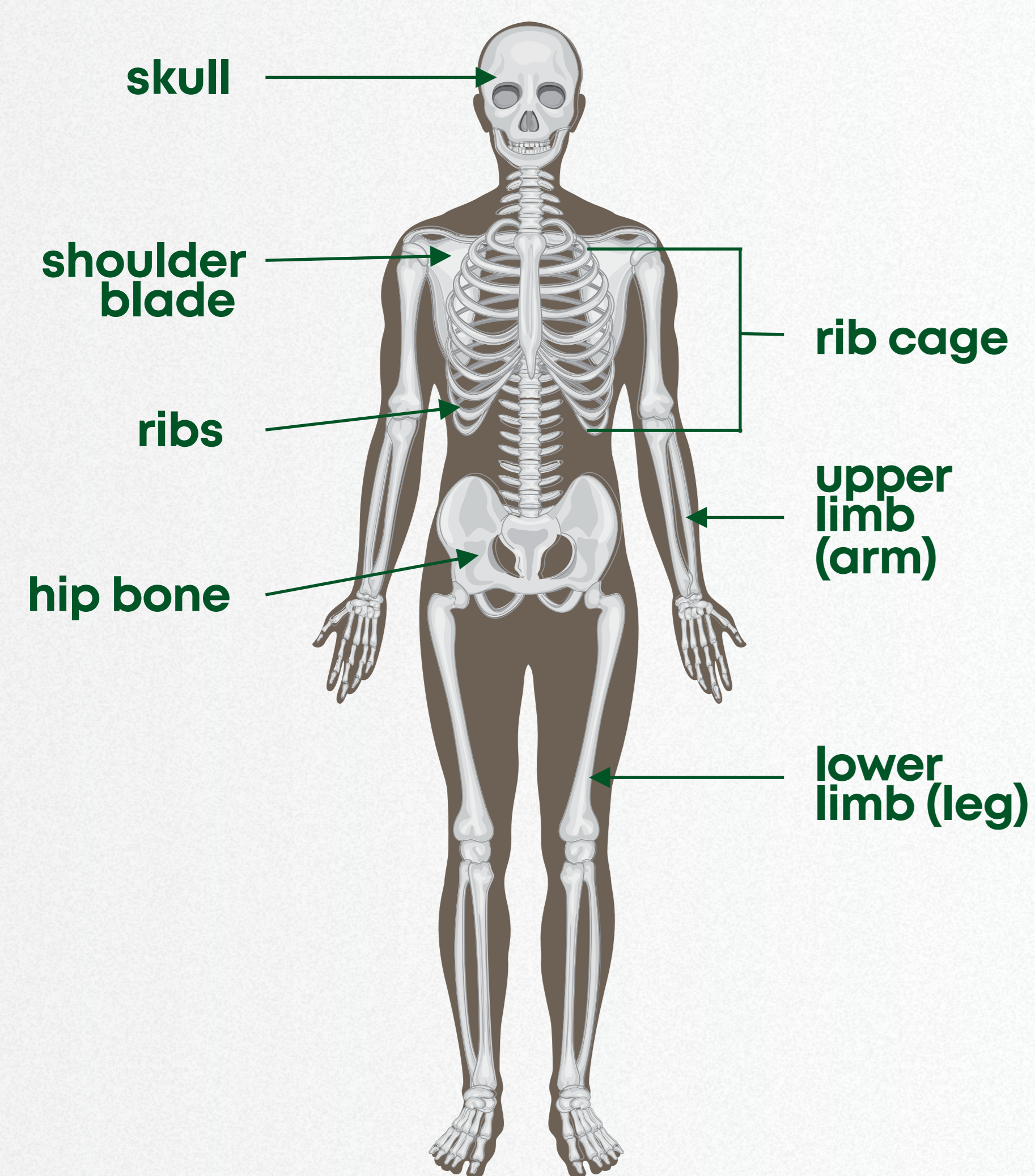
rest helps our bodies to recover and rebuild

keeping clean

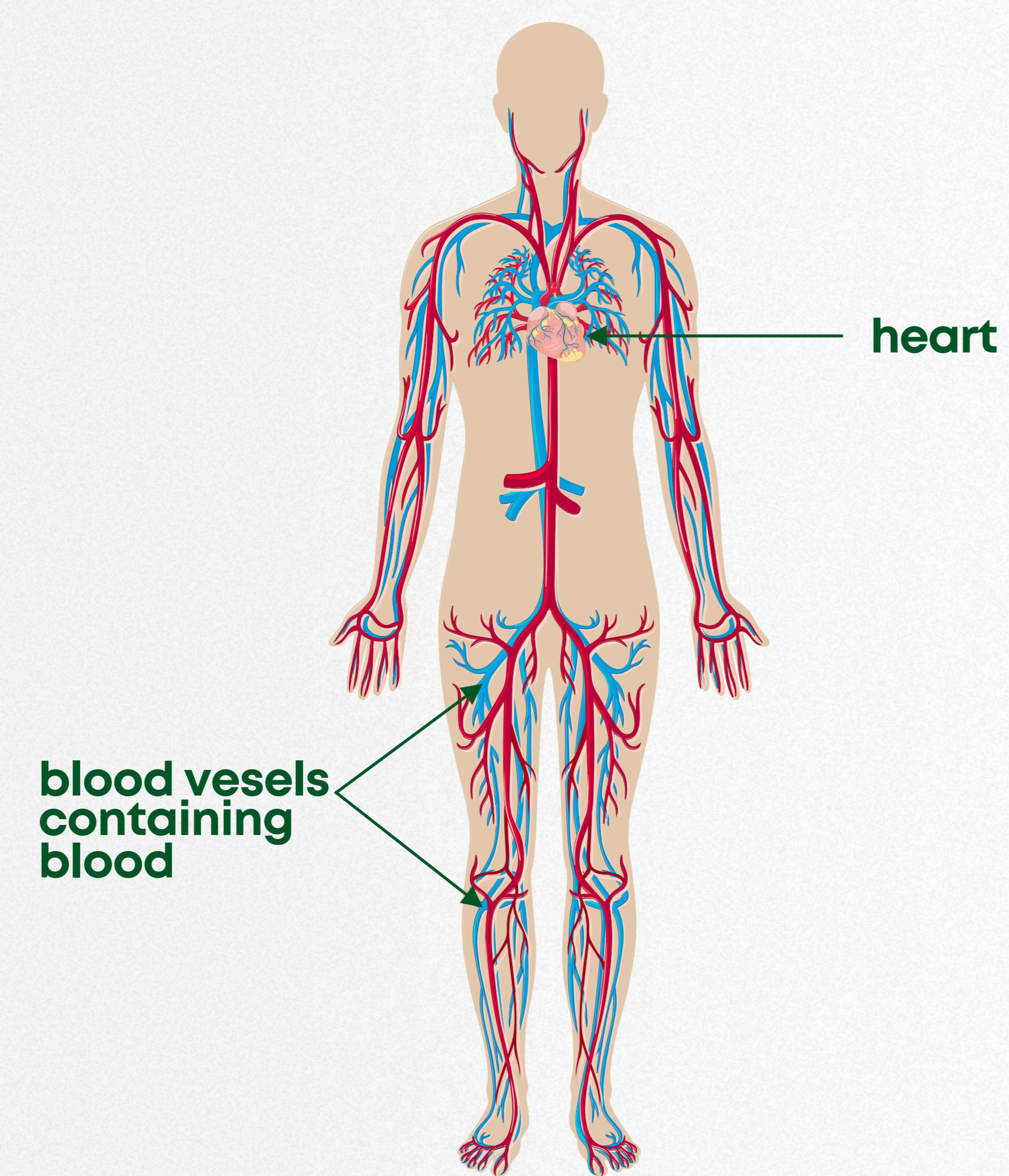
good hygiene prevents germs from spreading

medicines

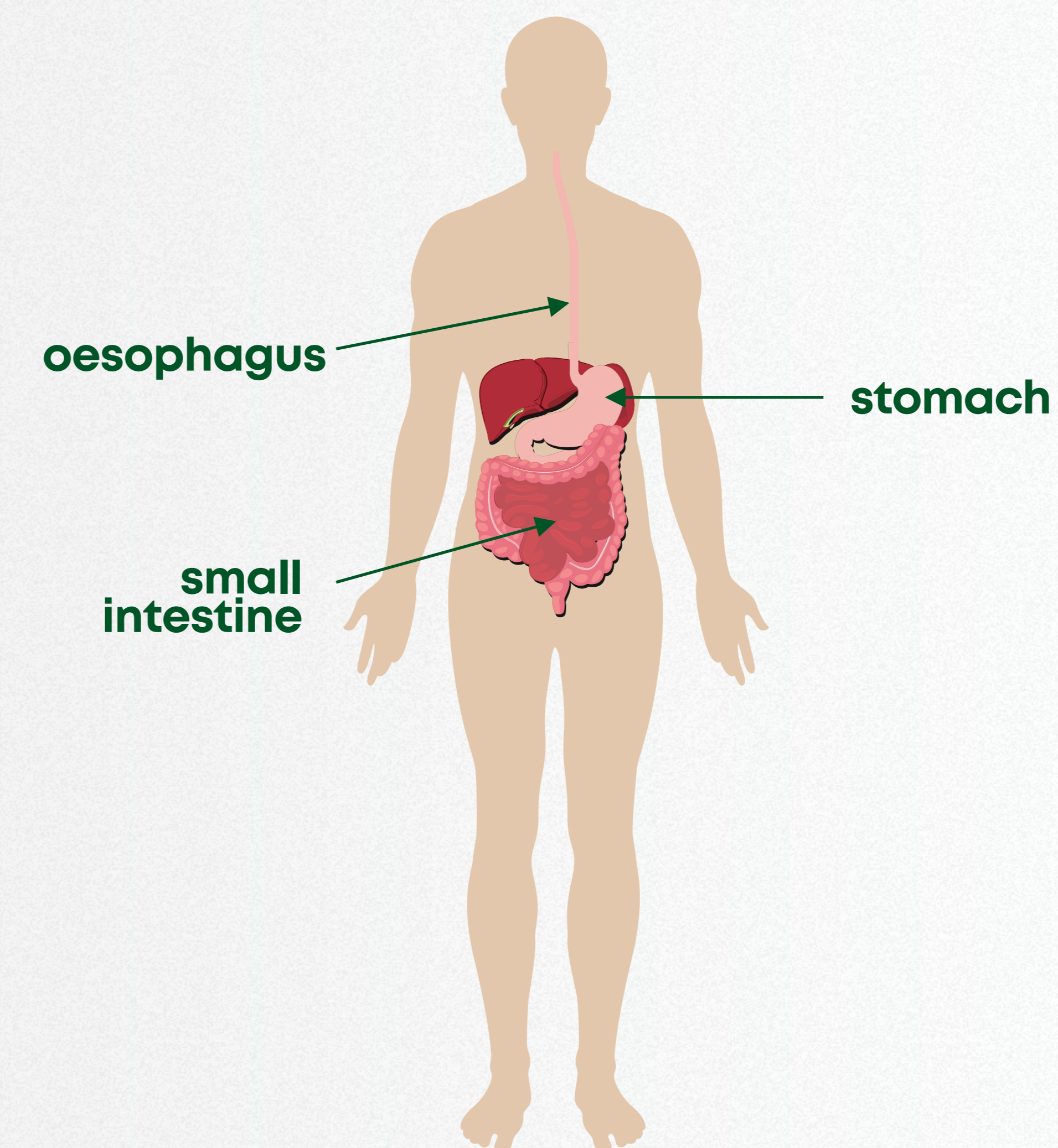

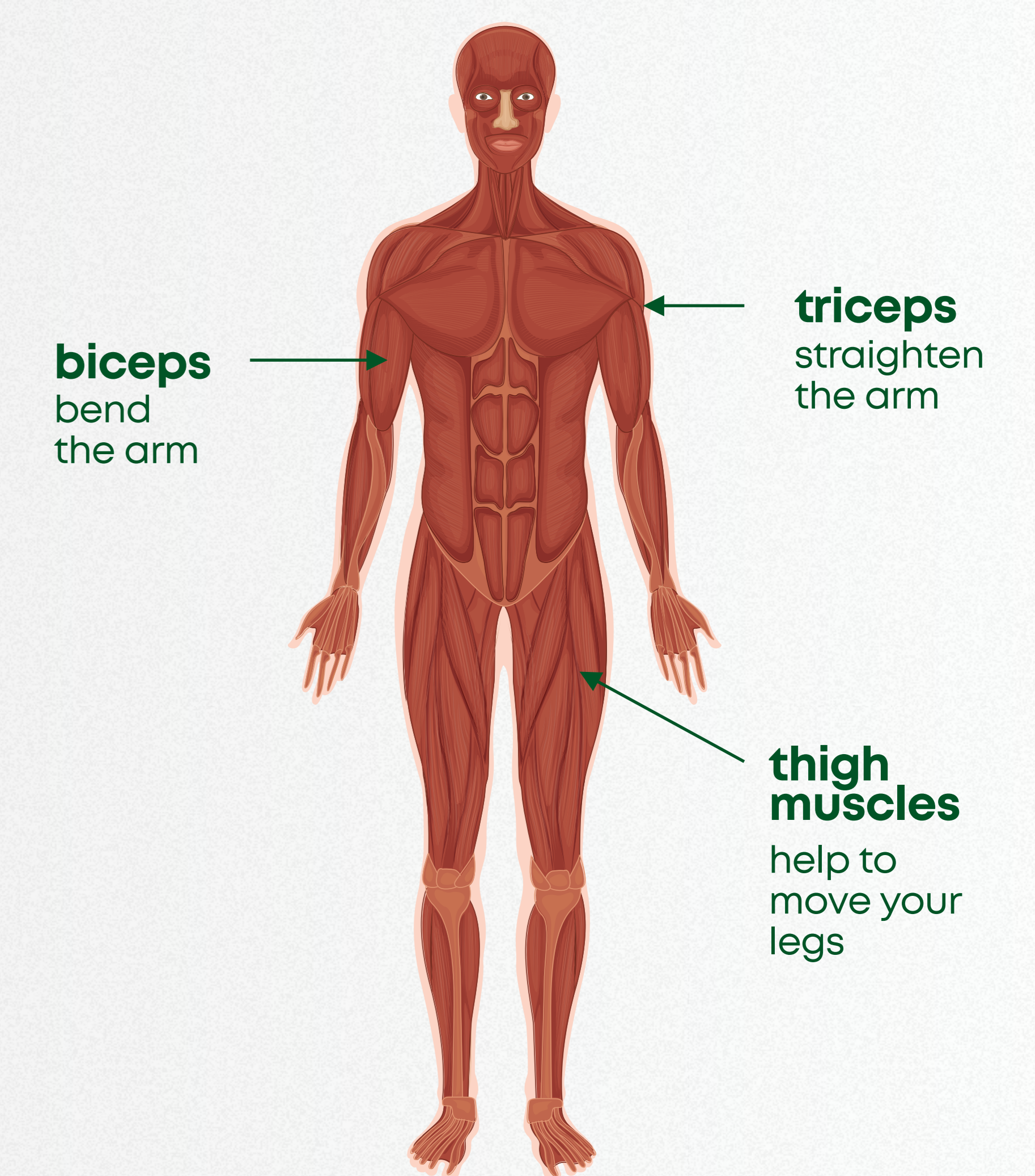
skeletal system
