Dear Parents and Carers of Year 3,

I write with some disappointing news regarding the planned Year 3 residential visit to CHET.

Due to an error out of our control during the booking process last year, we have unfortunately not been able to secure a place for our Year 3 cohort at CHET. Despite multiple efforts to rectify this, CHET have been unable to accommodate us this academic year.

As a school, we fully understand how much the children – and so many of you as families – were looking forward to this experience; we share this disappointment. Residentials are a valuable opportunity to enhance the curriculum and enrich children's lives, as well as growing in confidence, independence and friendship, and we are sorry that this one cannot go ahead as planned.

Since discovering the issue, we have spent a significant amount of time and resource exploring a range of alternative venues and considered replacing the residential with a meaningful day trip. However, after careful consideration, we have not found an alternative that offers the same quality or purpose, and we do not feel it would be a responsible use of time, resources or money to go ahead with something that falls short. We thank you for your understanding.
