Dear Parents and Carers,

As your child begins their final year at St. Gregory's in September, we are delighted to share some exciting information about one of the most anticipated experiences of Year 6: our residential trip to **Robinwood in Wrexham**.

Robinwood is a specialist outdoor activity centre, offering three unforgettable days filled with adventure, challenge, teamwork and joy. From canoeing to climbing, archery to the famous 'Piranha Pool', the residential gives children the chance to push themselves, discover new skills, and build lasting memories with their classmates. For many, it becomes a true highlight of primary school life—a 'rite of passage' that marks the start of a special and significant final year.

This residential trip will take place from **Wednesday 1st to Friday 3rd July 2026**

The total cost of the residential will be: **£ 408.00**

We require a non refundable deposit of: **£ 40.00** by 30.08.25 this will then secure your child's place. Should you change your mind after confirming your child will be attending the trip for whatever reason, you will lose the deposit.

This can then be followed by monthly payments of approximately **£40**. This payment plan will be set out on Parentpay, once we receive your completed form on the school app.

Should you decide not to enter into a payment plan and would like to make the full payment, we simply ask that you confirm your child's place to join the Y6 Robinwood residential by paying the initial deposit by 31st August and completing the relevant form on the school app, then make your payment of remaining balance on Parentpay.

This letter is to provide you with the background and give you the opportunity to begin a payment plan ahead of the new school year, should you wish to do so. By starting early, families can spread the cost over 10 months, making smaller, manageable payments.

Should you decide not to begin a 10month payment plan, we simply ask that you confirm whether you intend for your child to join the Y6 residential by completing the relevant form on the school app.

There will be further information shared in Year 6, including details about what the children can expect during their time away. For now, we hope this early notice helps with planning and budgeting, and allows everyone who would like to attend the chance to do so.
