Dear parents/carers,

As a Catholic primary school, our mission is to provide a high quality education rooted in the values of faith, compassion and community. In order to support the continued delivery of our faith based curriculum, religious education resources, and pastoral care programs, we kindly remind families of the importance of the Catholic School Levy.

Archdiocese of Liverpool cover a percentage of costs towards repairs, maintenance and building developments. We are very fortunate to have benefited from the funds in recent years, in particular refurbishment of children's toilets, refurbishment of school kitchen and roof repairs. As you can imagine, the Archdiocese has to raise in excess of £300,000 each year for schools. Catholic schools have agreed they would try to raise funds to support this amount.

Based on the number of families we currently have at St. Gregory's, we have been asked to raise **£10 per family**. In the past, we have always received a good response from our families to this request and hope that you support this once more this year.

The school levy has to be sent over to Archdiocese prior to the new academic year commencing and we would ask that prompt payments are received. The £10 will be added to your oldest child's Parentpay account, if you have more than one child attending our school.
